

2017 Conference: 55 proposals submitted, 65 persons registered before April 20th!



We have received 55 proposals: about 32 proposals were submitted for oral presentation, 15 as a poster, and 8 as a workshop. Proposals were submitted from the following countries or regions: Switzerland (13), Netherlands (7), Belgium (5), England (5), Germany (4), Finland (3), USA (3), Middle-East (3), Asia (3), Canada (2), Brazil (2), Denmark (1), Scotland (1), Italy (1), and Australia (1). So 70% were from European countries. Congratulations to Switzerland for having the most proposals submitted. The authors receive notification of acceptance before May 10th. The deadline for registration at normal rate is on May 20th. The provisional program will be available by mid May.

News from the WCC

EIPEN holds the chair of WCC this year and one of the important things to do is to develop guidelines for future WCC Conferences in terms of organization, supervision, content management, quality management, and also financial management. In the past years EIPEN has worked hard to establish a management structure for management and decision-making in the WCC. It is not easy to reach a consensus or full agreement with the different network members, but we succeeded. One of the next steps is to establish a transparency of financial management of the WCC Conference and to make possible that a percentage of the profit gained is used for common goals of the WCC. To increase the priority with the conference organizers, even if the continuous work of the working WCC contributes to the success of the conference. The entrepreneurship of the future WCC Conference needs to be supported by a solid and transparent system. The working group to develop these guidelines consists of the WCC Chair and 3 other WCC member representatives. More news to the end of 2016.

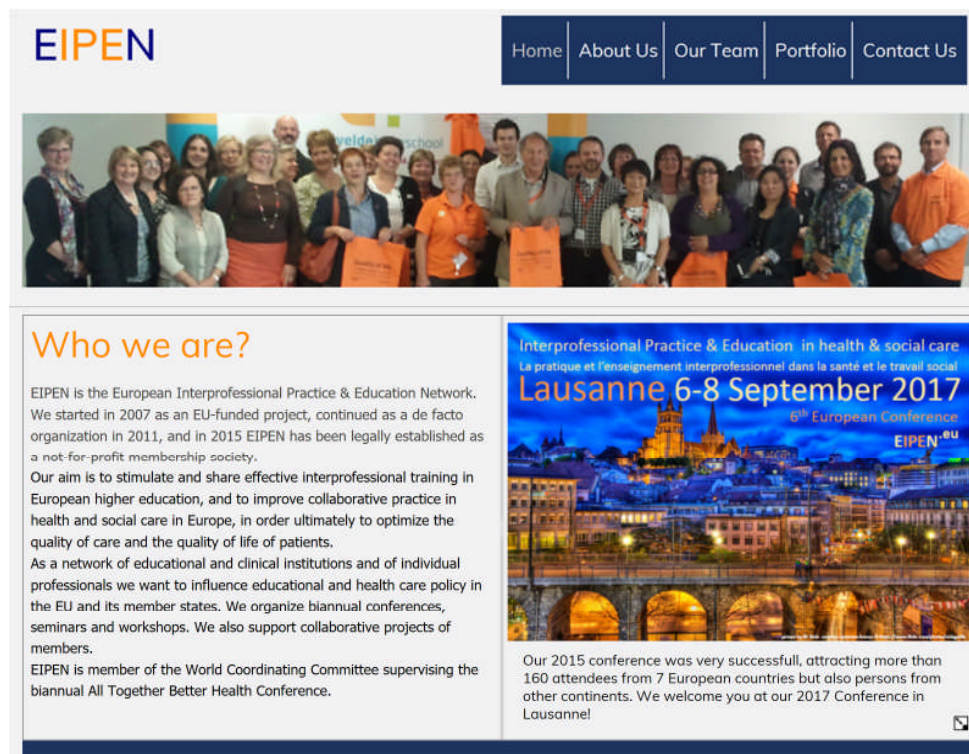
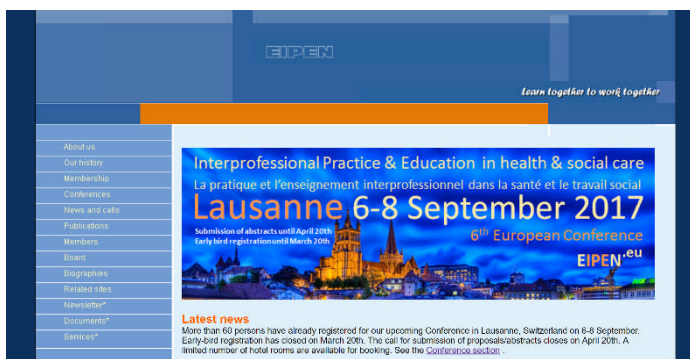
