We organise several trips outdoor and sportactivities, we go to art galleries, theatres, , ... over the 6 – 7 study-years we have.

On Technical level, we have the economic sector.

In the sector business – secretary- languages, we spend more attention to general knowledge. On the one hand modern languages (French and English - German) on the other hand we teach business, office management and economy.

The pupils are familiar with specific secretary functions, like dactylo, informatics, office management, word processing. Also fiscal and social law are elements for them.

In the 6th year the people have 3 weeks of practical training in local workplaces, where they obtain more important experience.

Several workplaces have already presented them a job before the end of their school year.

Since they have o lot of practice in administration, they easily can obtain a job in financial sectors or insurance sectors,...

The other sector, computer management, is fascinating for the pupils. (computers, internet, multimedia). In their last year, they are able to repair computers, install computers, install software and of course use them, they also are able to make websites, power-point presentations, ...

On Professional level, we have a hard sector (electricity, Sanitary/Central heating installations, mechanical) and a soft sector (nursing).

In these sectors the pupils have a lot of practices. Even at school they have constructed a class with electricity, windows, isolation, ...

They also have trainee period of practical training.

After their 6th and 7th year, they can start in the real world.

RECAPITULATION OF THE PROJECT

Our projects are designed for our students of the 6th year technical education: secretary languages and computer management, commerce and logistics. At the end of the school year the students will have obtained a diploma of secondary education.

Our students of the technical level will get a very thorough preparation in many fields. We will pay special attention to language and culture and prepare them educationally and emotionally.

Our students are supervised by experts, before during and after the internship



The projects always start in the month of March. The students will first learn about the partner organization and their employees. (from October till march)

After the introduction period the students run various businesses in line with the objectives in mind of the 6th year TSO. We expect them to act as full employees. The supervisors will check this and if necessary take steps.



During the internship the students keep daily reports and are regularly evaluated by the internship provider and the mentors.



Since most students travel for the first time in groups for a longer period a lesson in civility is given, they are also prepared professionally, emotionally and financially. A teambuilding session is organized.

There will be paid attention to the English language as well. Students from last school year who have already participated in an internship abroad have reported their findings and explain how they have experienced it. The teachers who already have experienced internships provide information to the students.

The cultural preparation is included in several teachers' courses and in the lessons of word processing.

Back home all task documents and final reports must be finished in two days



When they succeed in the 6th year students will receive in addition to a certificate of secondary education a Europass, signed by 3 parties as evidence of their training abroad in cooperation with the Leonardo da Vinci project.

THE EUROPASS

The Europass is a European recognized certificate as proof of your internship abroad.

This document can later be used when applying in Belgium and any European country.

INFORMATION INSURANCE

The Travel insurance that assists the students in the school on behalf of multi-day excursion.

There is also intervention provided in medical expenses due to illness abroad.

The student, who has suffered physical damage, should immediately report to the accompanying teacher.

The school has an endorsed insurance for civil liability for bodily injury accidents at school and judicial protection of pupils.

The civil liability is at risk when accidents caused by pupils to fellow students or others, happen outside the supervision by the school (In that case we appeal to the family insurance)
